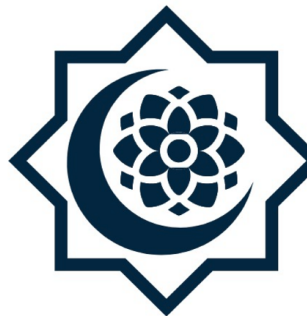


Figure 1.3.: C. The Muhammad Dahhan Lineage [Based on Bradley (2010: 524–527)]



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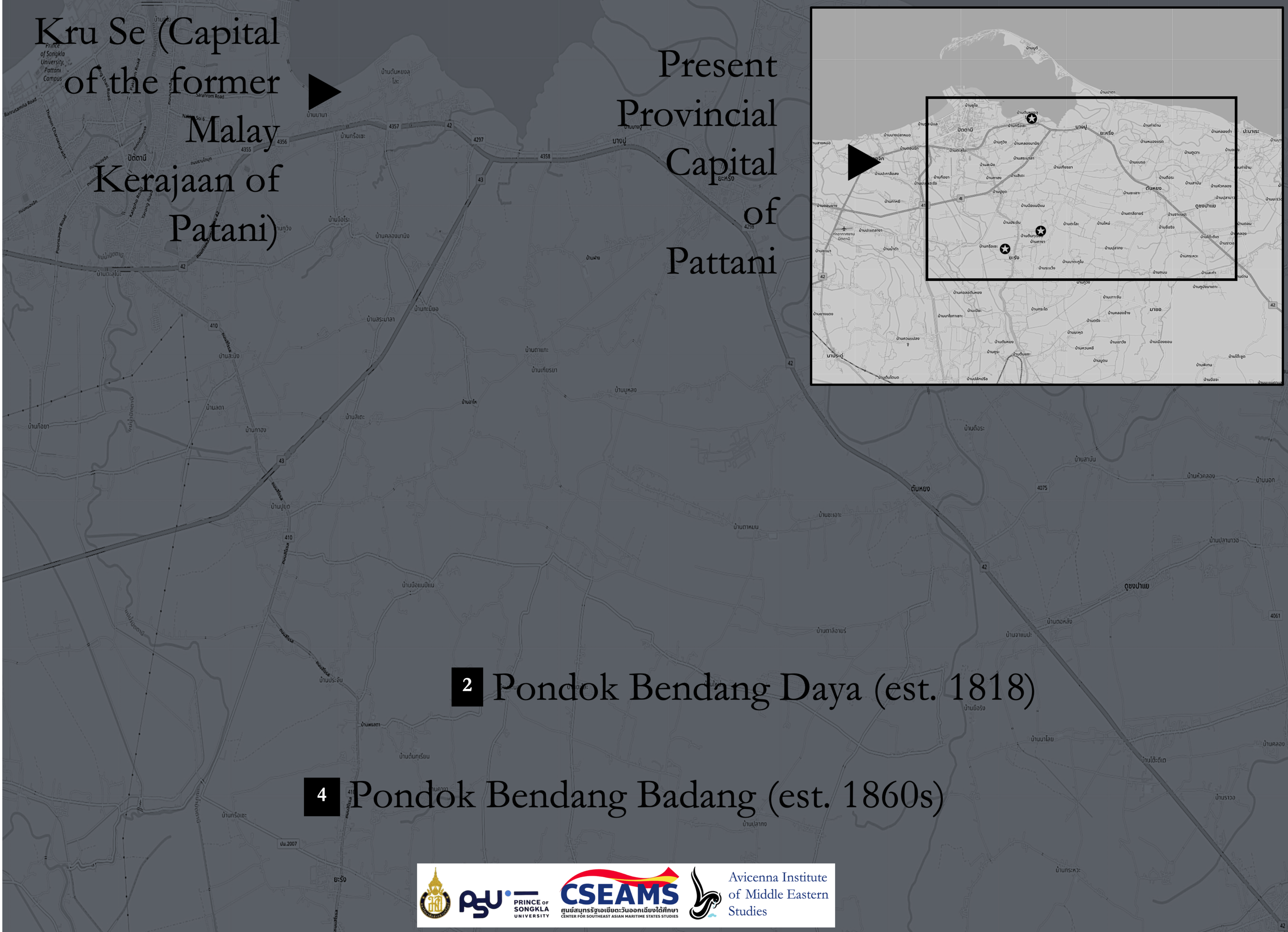
