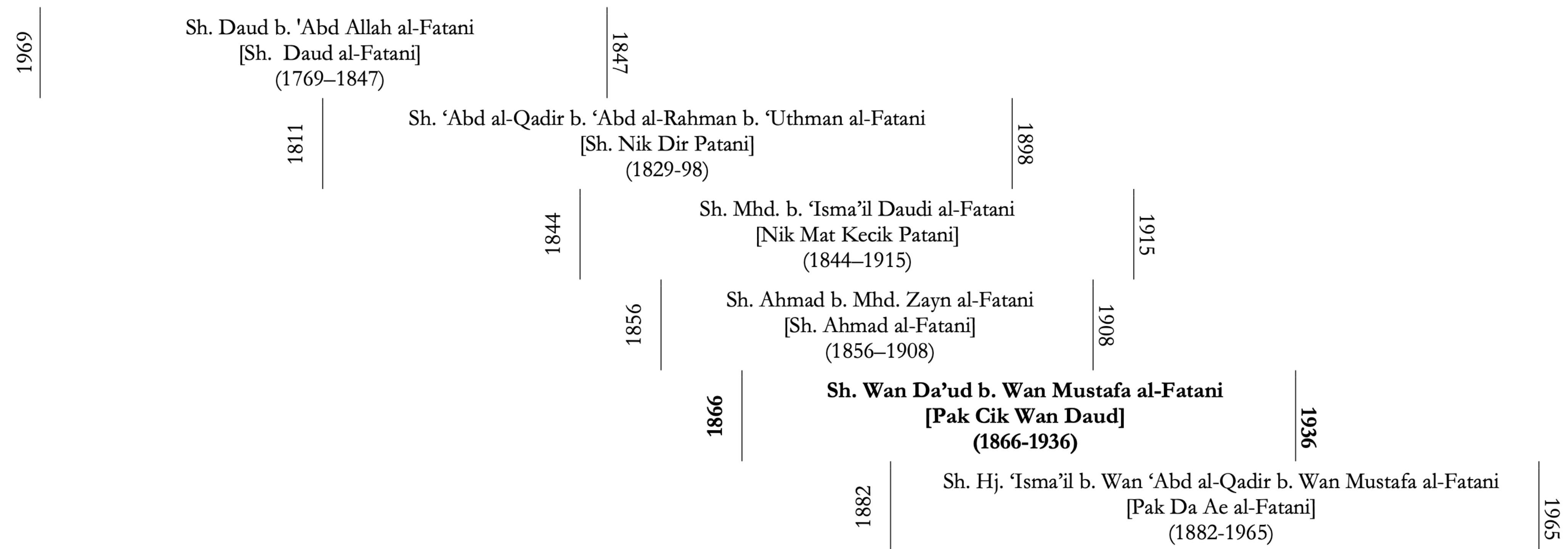


Figure 2.5.: Sh. Wan Da'ud b. Wan Mustafa al-Fatani [Pak Cik Wan Daud] (1866-1936)



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Biographical Details

b. 1283/1866 (Bendang Daya), d. 1936 (Mecca). Son of Tok Bendang Daya Tua. Brother of Tok Bendang Daya Muda, Sh. Mhd. Zayn b. Mustafa al-Fatani. Nephew of Sh. Ahmad b. Mhd. Zayn al-Fatani. Studied with father (Tok Bendang Daya Tua), before travelling to Mecca where he taught until his death.

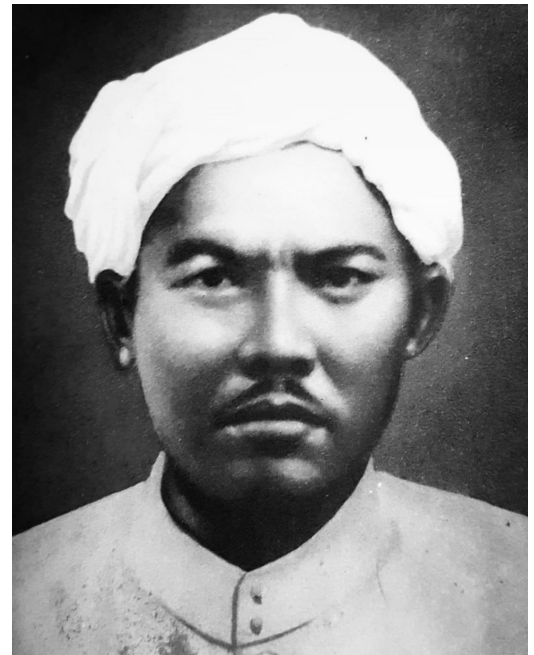
Brief Biography: b. 1844, in Pulau Duyong Kecil, Kuala Terengganu to Patani refugees. d. 1915, in Mecca. Father was Wan 'Isma'il b. Wan Ahmad b. Wan 'Idris. His mother was the daughter of Sh. 'Idris (Sh. Da'ud al-Fatani's younger brother). Adopted by Sh. Da'ud around 1845. Raised in Mecca.
