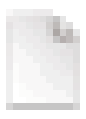


Figure 2.7.: Hj. Mhd. Dahhan b. Da’ud [Tok Yaman] (1860s–1956) 



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Brief Biography:	Born in Kampung Beruas Mulu, Penarik, Patani, in the 1860s. Contemporaries of Tok Kelaba, Tok Bermin, and Tok Jakar. Studies in local pondok, including Pondok Bendang Daya. Accompanied Hj. ‘Abd Allah Bendang Gucil and Hj. ‘Ibrahim Musa Bendang Gucil to Yemen to study with Sh. Yusuf al-Yamani for 5 years. Returned to Mecca, where he lived for 5 more years. Returned to Patani.
