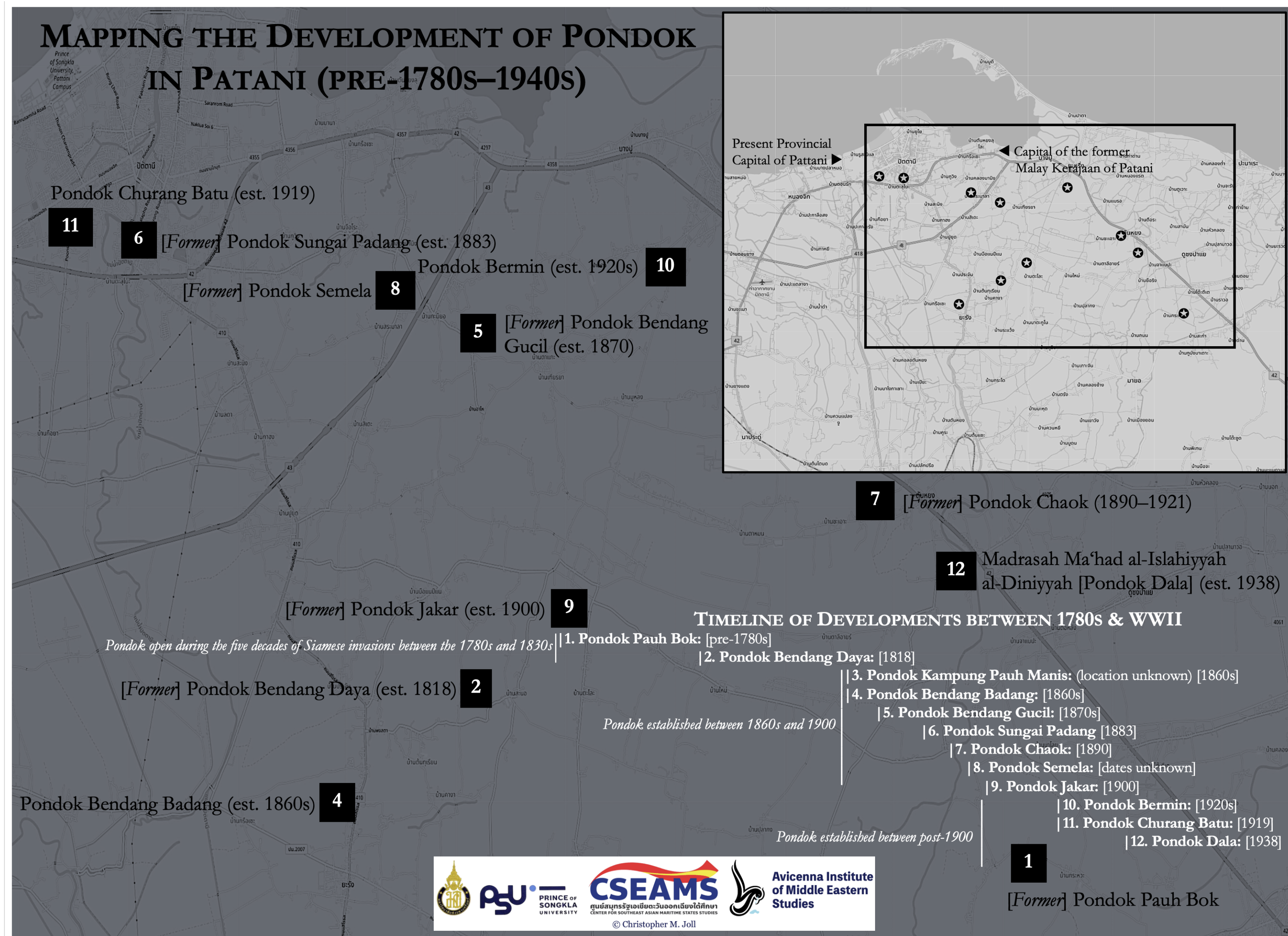


Figure 3.10. Pondok Bermin Established by Wan Ahmad b. Wan 'Idris in the 1920s

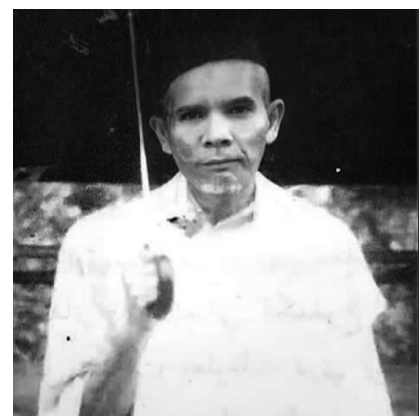
