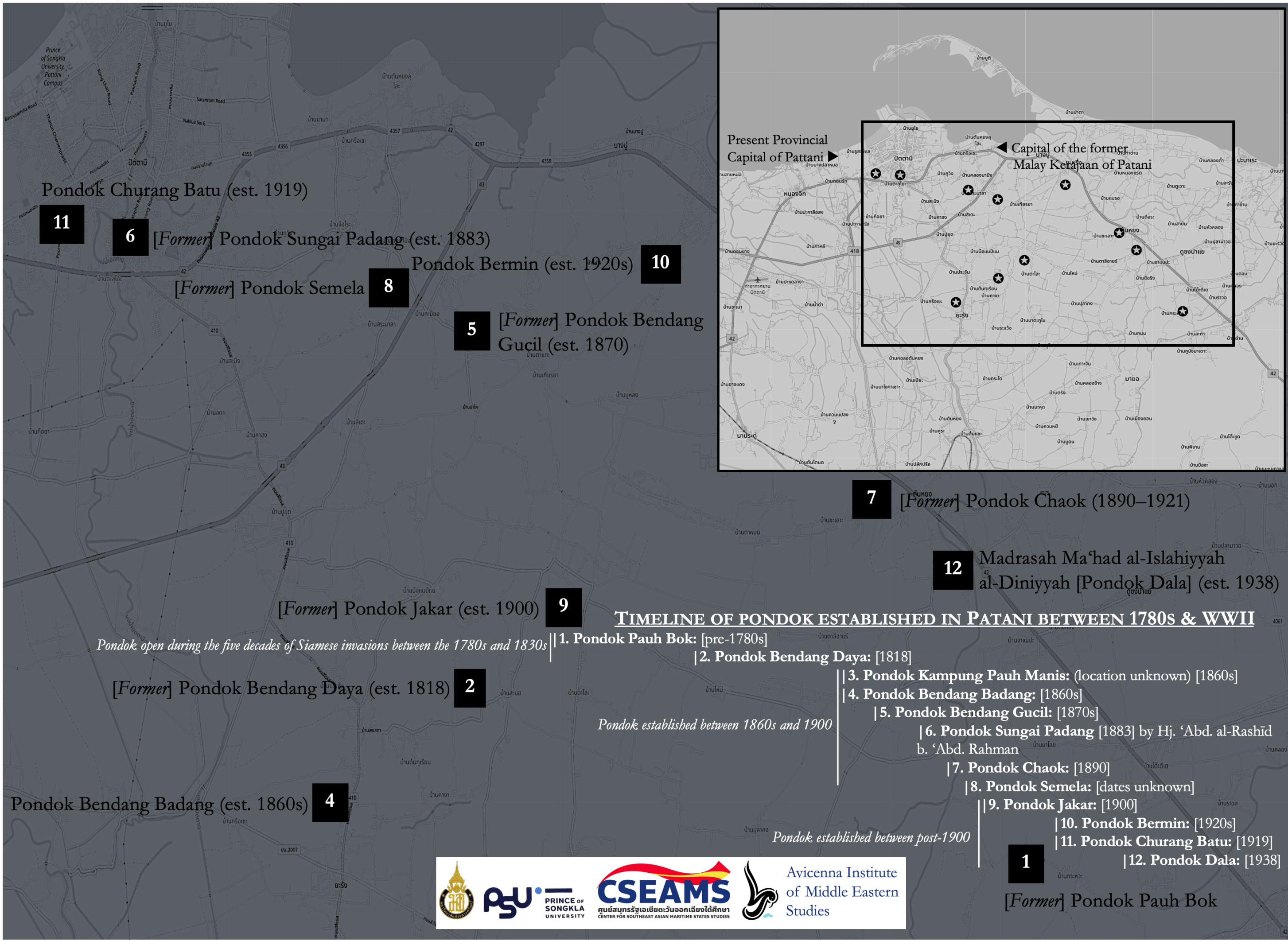

Brief Biography: Grandson of 1.1. Contemporary of Sh. Da'ud al-Fatani in Mecca. Returned sometime before 1820s. Became leader of Pondok Pauh Bok, and taught the kitab of Sh. Da'ud al-Fatani

Sh 'Ali b. Ishaq al-Fatani (fl. 1243/1828)
