


Figure 3.4.: Pondok Bendang Daya established by Hj. Wan b. Wan Mhd. Faqih al-Fatani (1883)

2.1. Hj. Wan b. Wan Mhd. Faqih al-Fatani [Tok Bendang Daya Tua]

Brief Biography: Came from an elite family. Commanded one of the Raja's armies in the 1831-2 war. Grandfather of SAAF

2.2. Sh. Hj. 'Abd al-Qadir b. Haji Mustafa b. Mhd. Faqih al-Fatani (1818-95) [Tok Bendang Daya Muda].

Brief Biography: 2.2. was son of 2.1., younger brother of Mhd. Zayn b. Mustafa al-Fatani, and Abd al-Latif. Sent to Mecca with older brother Mhd. Zayn b. Mustafa al-Fatani. He was contemporary of Sh. Nawawi al-Bantani and Sh. 'Ali bin 'Abd al-Rahman al-Kalantani. His brother, 'Abd al-Latif joined him in Mecca. Daughter Aminah married 'Isma'il Sena. Their son was Tuan Guru Hj. 'Abd al-Qadir b. 'Isma'il al-Sanawi. Returned to Patani. Taught as chief teacher at Pondok Bendang Daya. Went to Mecca (1894) to assist members of the royal family on hajj.




