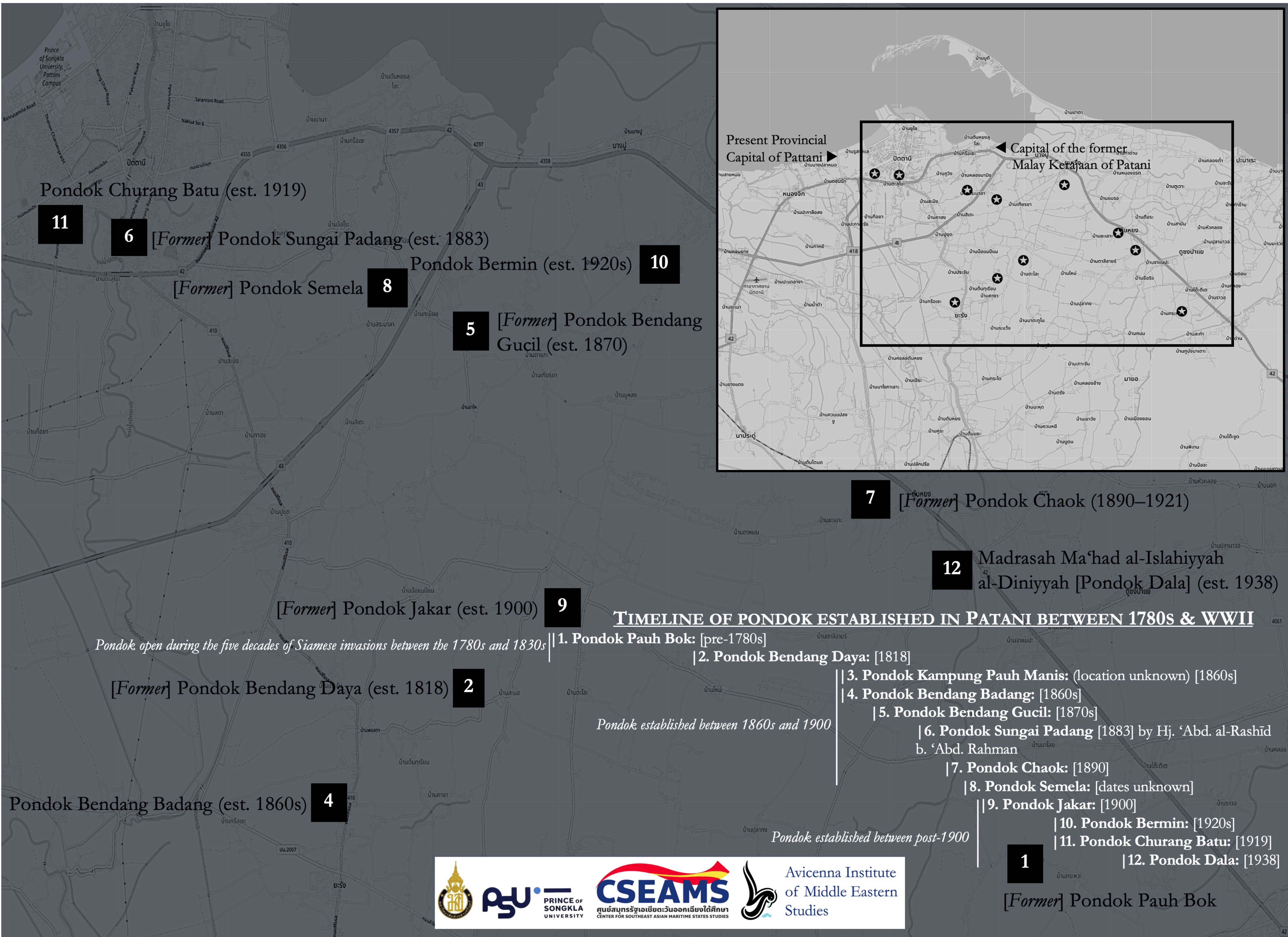


Figure 3.5. Pondok Bendang Badang est. by Sh. Mhd. Zayn al-'Abidin b. Mhd. al-Fatani [Tuan Minal] (1860s)



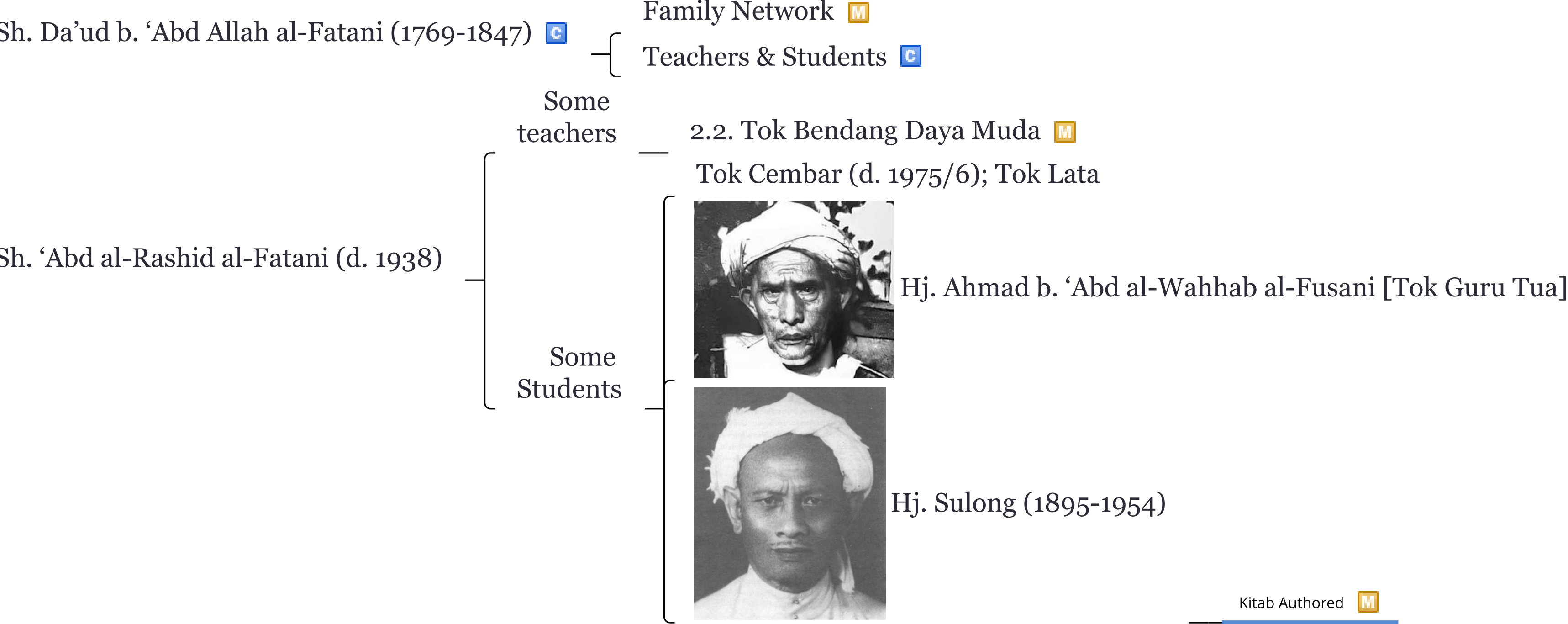
Brief Biography

Saman ‘Abd al-Rahman, father of Tuan Guru Haji Hussein Rahimi, Kelantan; Hj. Senik b. Salih, from Kampung Teras Besar, Mentuan, Kota Bharu, d. c. 1902; Tok Keramat Pulau Bidan (d. 1938), his son-in-law
