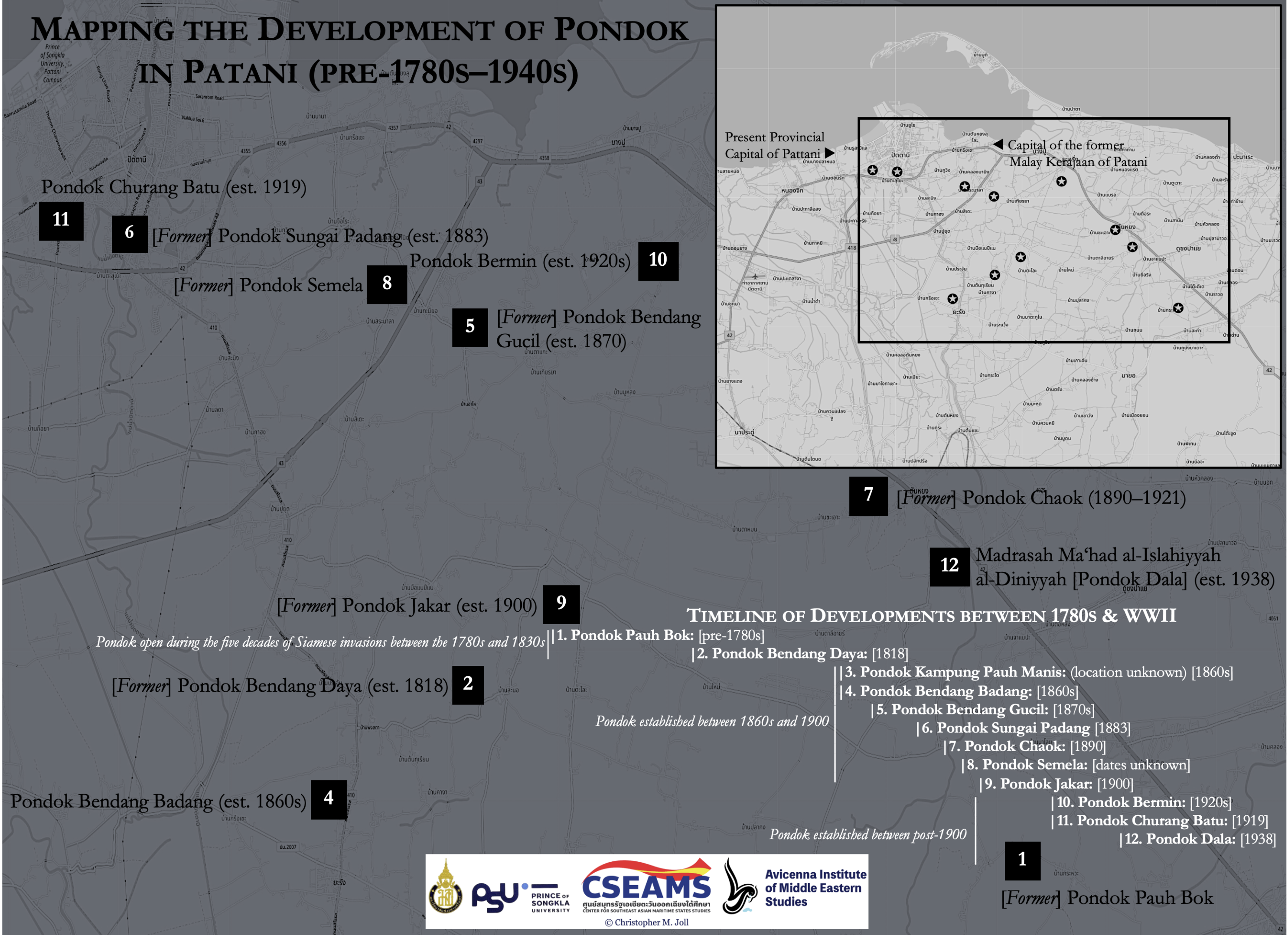


Figure 3.6. Pondok Bendang Gucil established by Hj. Mhd. Salih in the 1870s

Brief Biography

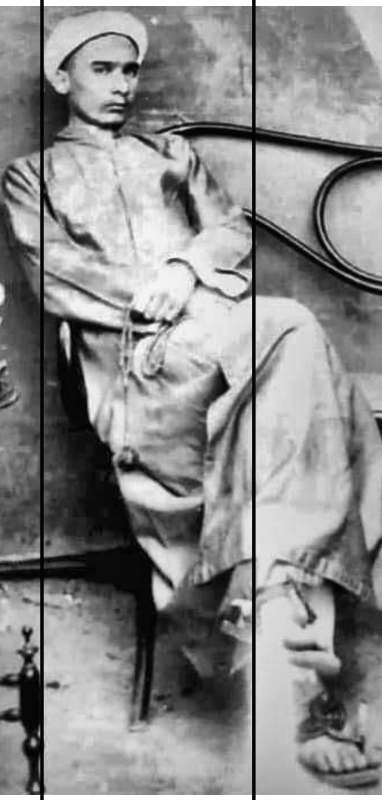
b. 1870, in Bendang Gucil. d. 1946. Studied at Pondok Bendang Gucil, and Bendang Daya. Friend of Tok Yaman. Studied in Mecca and Yemen (for five years) with Tok Yaman and Haji 'Ibrahim Musa Bendang Gucil. Returned to Patani around 1900. Became second teacher at Pondok Bendang Gucil.

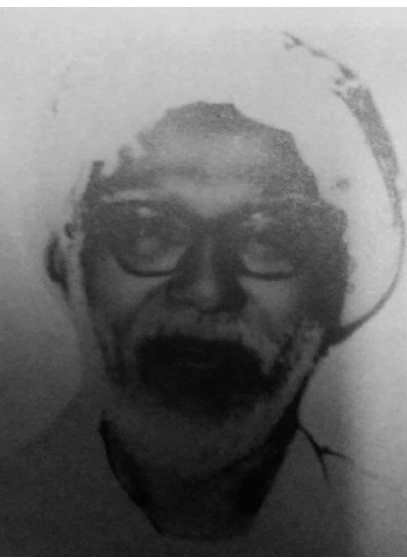

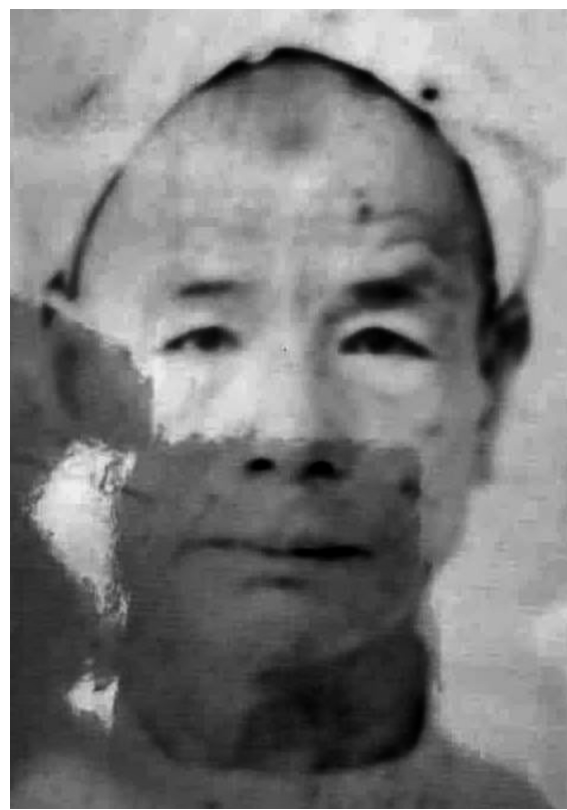
