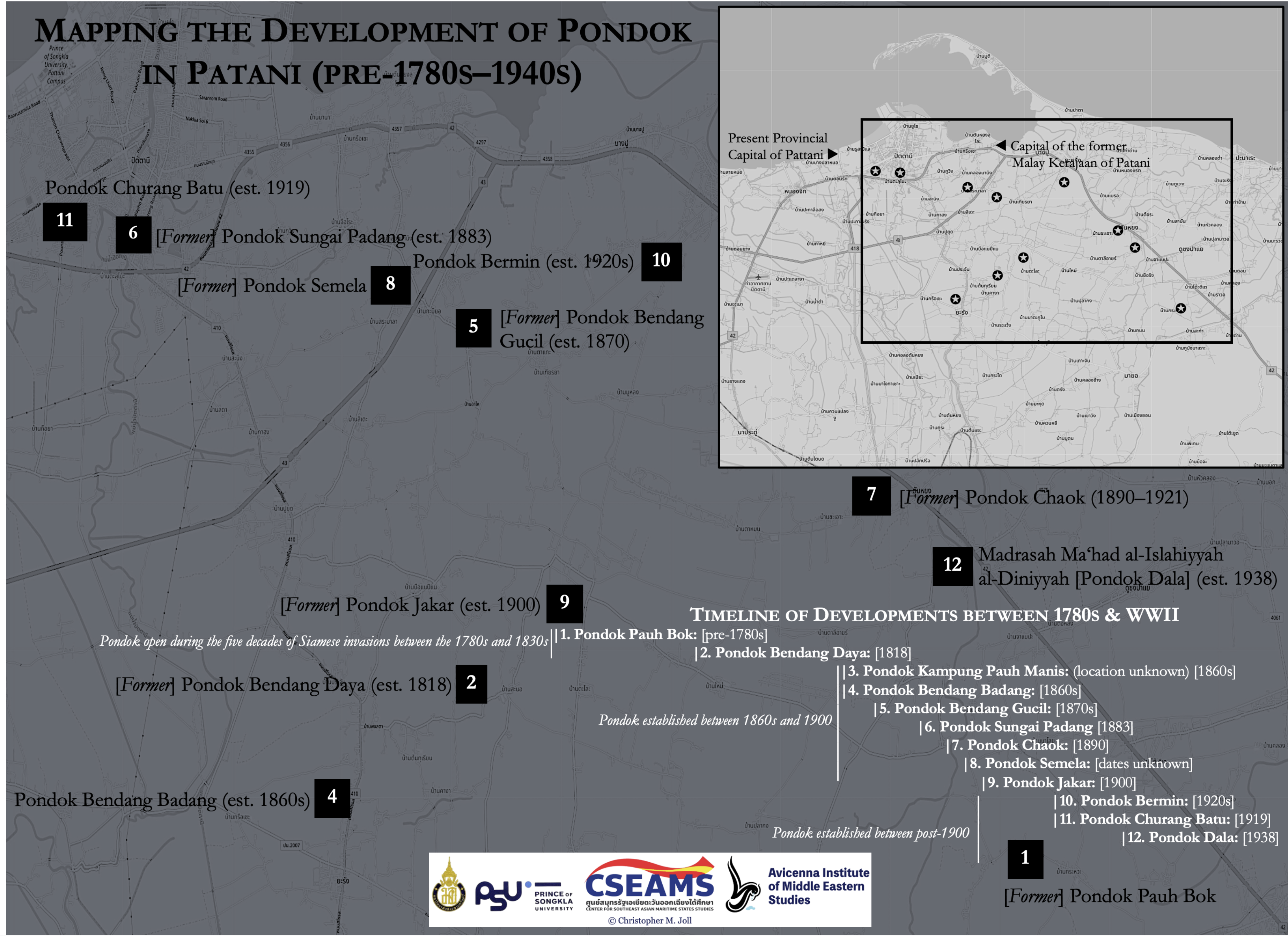


Figure 3.9. Pondok Jakar established by Hj. ‘Abd al-Samad b. Mhd. Saman al-Naufi al-Fatani (1900)
